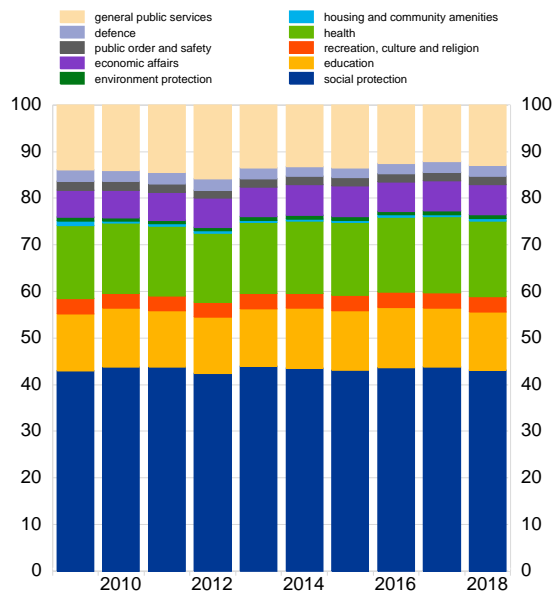

C1 Total expenditure by function

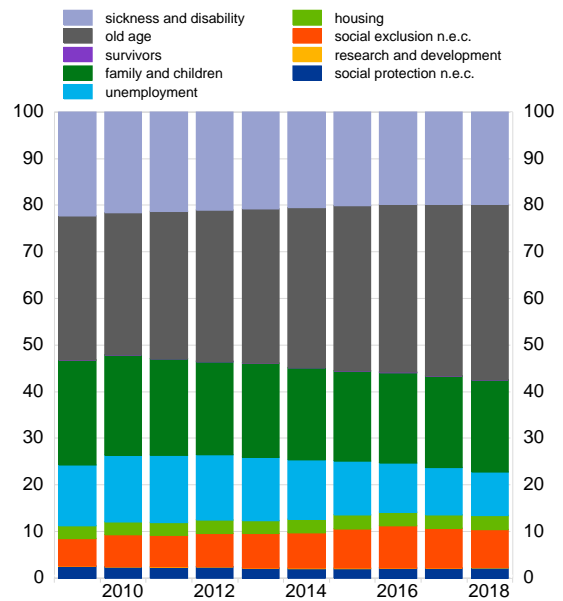
(as a percentage of total expenditure)
